First Reading: April 15, 2015 (Hoppe/Leon)
Second Reading: May 6, 2015

Whereas, at the February 18, 2015, meeting of the Imperial Valley College Academic Senate, Dr. Victor Jaime and Dr. Nicholas Akinkuoye presented a plan for the reorganization of agriculture from the Science, Math, and Engineering Department to the Business Department; and

Whereas, agriculture is predominantly an applied science; and

Whereas, agriculture programs are in science departments in a majority of California Community Colleges; and

Whereas, it is the consensus of the Science Department at IVC that Agriculture remain in the sciences.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Academic Senate of Imperial Valley College supports keeping the Agriculture program in the Science, Math and Engineering Department, reporting to the Math and Sciences Dean.
