Check with each UC Campus
Exceptions to 60 transferrable units and minimum admission requirements?	<p>YES,</p> <p>CSU campuses will clear admission for upper-division transfer applicants with 48 semester transferable units who have completed English Language (A2) and mathematics/quantitative reasoning (B4) by the start of fall 2020 (including courses taken in summer 2020).</p>	<p>It depends:</p> <p>Completing minimum requirements by spring is a selection criterion used by many of our campuses. Students who will need summer coursework to meet minimum requirements due to spring course cancellations should work directly with their UC campus admissions office to determine any potential impact on an admission decision.</p>
