Placement

Enrollment in college level English and Mathematics courses requires appropriate placement as defined by AB705. All students should see a counselor for a customized Student Education Plan (SEP) before enrolling in college courses. The SEP provides students with individually appropriate course recommendations and accounts for course prerequisite sequencing.

Transfer Preparation

Associate degrees require the completion of certain general education courses. Transfer programs may require the completion of additional coursework depending on the institution. It is advisable to meet with an academic counselor for more information.
