Associate in Arts for Transfer (AA-T) Degree

Placement

Enrollment in college level English and Mathematics courses requires appropriate placement as defined by AB705. All students should see a counselor for a customized Student Education Plan (SEP) before enrolling in college courses. The SEP provides students with individually appropriate course recommendations and accounts for course prerequisite sequencing.

Transfer Preparation

The Associate in Science for Transfer [AS-T] and Associate in Arts for Transfer [AA-T] are intended for students who plan to complete a Bachelor's Degree in a similar major at a CSU campus. Students completing this degree are guaranteed admission to the CSU system, but not to a particular campus or major. Please refer to the Imperial Valley College general catalog for more information on the "Requirements for the AA-T or AS-T." This major can be completed using CSU GE-B or IGETC. Students using IGETC must complete Oral Communication (1C) to be eligible for admission to the CSU system.
