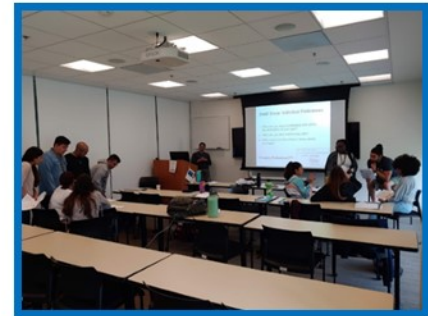


# UniversityLink Medical Science Program 2021
